WHAT NOT TO DROP:

- Needles/lancets/ syringes
- Thermometers
- IV bags
- Bloody or infectious waste
- Hydrogen peroxide
- Business waste (nursing, group homes, etc.)
- Empty containers
- Personal care products



Medicine take-back programs for disposal are a good way to remove expired, unwanted, or unused medicines from the home and reduce the chance that others may accidentally take the medicine. Watch for this opportunity to take place several times a year.
